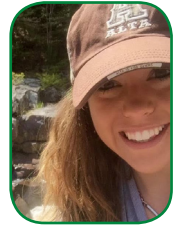

Rachel grew up at The Peoples Church, where she vividly remembers Sunday school, PCYG lock-ins, and running around with her brother in the stairwells when they were younger. She is currently enrolled at Michigan Technological University in a Peace Corps master's international program, with a focus in applied science education. At the end of this month, she will travel to Mozambique for 27 months to serve in the Peace Corps, teaching math at the secondary level. Rachel's desire to pursue the Peace Corps was sparked by several church mission trips, her love of teaching and the opportunity to earn a master's degree.



**ABOUT MOZAMBIQUE**

The Republic of Mozambique is a nation on the southeast coast of Africa, separated from the island nation of Madagascar by the Indian Ocean. Between the first and fifth centuries, Bantu-speaking peoples migrated from farther north and west. Swahili (and Arab) commercial ports existed along the coasts until the arrival of Europeans and colonization by Portugal in 1505. After over four centuries of Portuguese rule, Mozambique gained independence in 1975. The country descended into an intense and protracted civil war from 1977 to 1992. It is one of the poorest and most underdeveloped countries in the world, endowed with rich and extensive natural resources and an economy based largely on agriculture.
