# Congratulations on your engagement!

Marriage is a gift from God, given to all humankind for the wellbeing of the entire human family. Weddings are an occasion to celebrate this covenant while giving thanksgiving to God for the relationship of the couple with the support of the congregation of family and friends who join them in this service of worship.

Our staff is eager to help make your wedding day an authentic, worshipful and meaningful event in the lives of the couple and their families. We hope The Peoples Church will become your permanent church home during and after your preparation for marriage. Though wherever you go after your wedding, know the God of grace, compassion, and love will accompany you on your journey together.

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## Timeline to your wedding day

As you plan your wedding, we are here to help make it your day. Music is a key part of your celebration; anticipate meeting with our organist or sound specialists **at least two months** before your special day. Our Wedding Coordinator is here to smooth your way before and during the service and will meet and talk with you as plans proceed, particularly during the last two months and final weeks. You will be reminded to secure your marriage license at least one month before the date. Don't hesitate to ask questions along the way.



The People Church is committed to celebrating and sustaining life-giving, loving relationships. In order to do this, we utilize proven pre-marriage materials from the Prepare/ Enrich organization as part of our marriage preparation process.

Engaged couples are expected to meet at least three times with their presiding pastor and participate in one Saturday group seminar prior to their wedding day.

The group seminar and individual meetings are intended to provide tools and resources that will be helpful to the couple before and after their wedding day.

The Prepare/Enrich program materials assist with discussions about communication, goals and expectations, personality types and compatibility. They have been lauded by couples as one of the most helpful parts of the marriage preparation process.

A \$400 deposit is due to secure your wedding date. The remaining balance is due in full 30 days prior to your wedding day.

Cancellations may only be made in writing by the bride or groom. Cancellations made eight months or more before the wedding date receive a 50 percent refund on the deposit; four to eight months, 25 percent refund; and less than three months, no refund.

**Personnel Fees** include the compensation for the presiding minister, wedding coordinator, organist, building custodian and sound tech and include their time on the day of the wedding and before.

**Building Use Fees** support the mission of the church as they are invested into Building & Grounds costs and the Christian outreach ministries of the church.

\*Building Use Fees are waived for Members of The Peoples Church as they support the mission of the church through annual sharing of time, talent and treasure in the weekly offertory and service opportunities.
